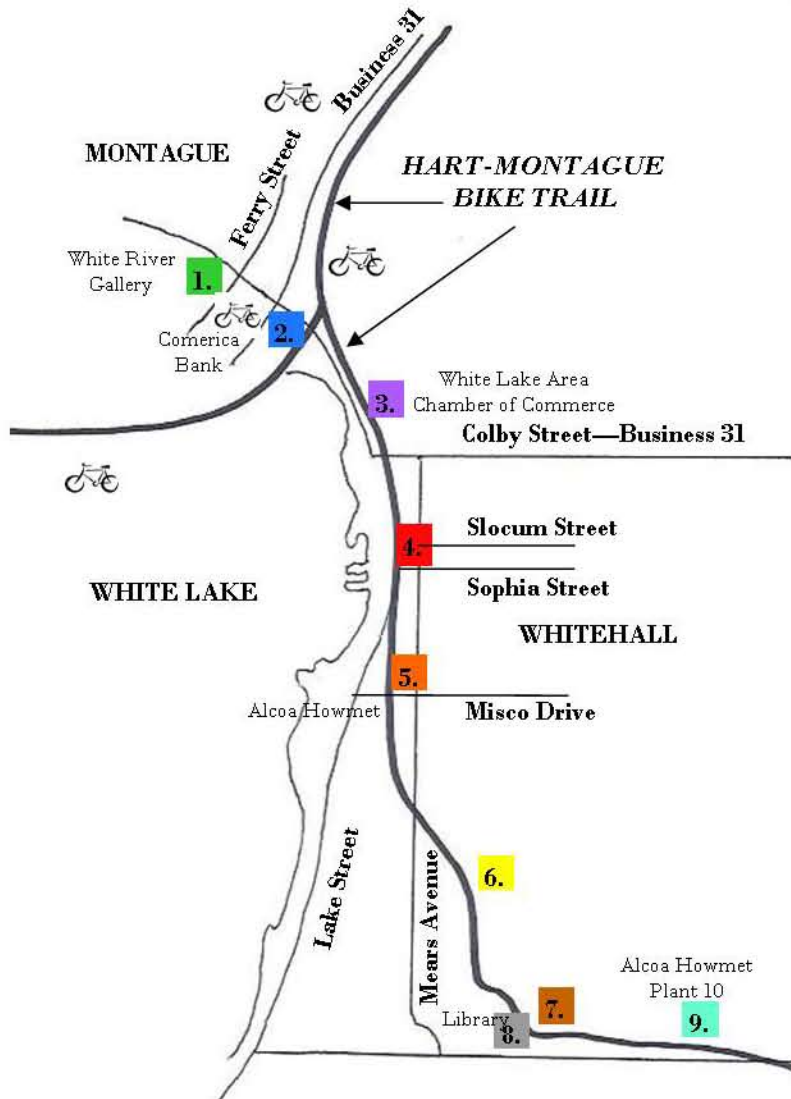

ART WALK SCULPTURES

The Arts Council of White Lake initiates and supervises the installation of sculptures along the Hart-Montague and the Montague-Berry Junction bicycle trails in the White Lake area. Since October of 2005, the ACWL has placed eight sculptures creating ART WALK.

The ACWL also sponsored "Flow", the relief sculpture by Robert L. Barnum, installed on the Dowling Street side of the White River Gallery in downtown Montague. A two block detour off the bike trail allows you to view this beautiful new sculpture as well as an opportunity to visit the White River Gallery where local artists display and sell their work.

Four artistic bike racks, also by Robert L. Barnum, are *Jazzman*, *A Good Book*, *Dancers* and *Fisherman*. They are scattered about the Montague community and are identified on the map inside this brochure.
